Michael R. Horsman is currently Professor of Experimental Radiotherapy at Aarhus University and works in the Department of Experimental Clinical Oncology (ECO), Aarhus University Hospital, Denmark. He obtained a BSc with Honors in Human Biology from Oxford Polytechnic in 1977, a PhD in Radiation Biology from the University of London in 1981, and a Doctor of Medical Science from Aarhus University in 1996. His first research appointment was at the Department of Therapeutic Radiology, Stanford University, California where he worked from 1981 to 1986, before joining ECO in 1987. He has published extensively on hyperthermia related topics, especially concerning the role of the tumor microenvironment and vasculature. He has received several awards, including the Lund Science Award (1988) and the ESHO-BSD Award (2011) for his contributions to hyperthermia. He has also been involved in numerous scientific conferences as a co-organizer, session chairperson, or invited speaker. In addition, he has been an Associate Editor or on the Editorial board of several International Scientific Journals, including the International Journal of Hyperthermia, and a Board member of the European Society for Hyperthermic Oncology (ESHO) serving as Secretary/Treasurer. He has also been a supervisor and examiner for a number of different Universities worldwide.
